



knowledge, motivation and competencies


to access, understand, appraise and apply information

to form judgment and take decisions in everyday life


in terms of healthcare, disease prevention and health promotion

Impact of limited health literacy

Poor health outcomes

Higher hospitalization rates

Higher use of emergency care

Lower use of preventive services

Poorer comprehension of medications

Increase in healthcare costs at over \$73 billion annually (US)










Where does it go wrong?


A few reasons why it goes wrong...
